VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

PARENT COURSE FACILITATOR: Assists the Parent Development Coordinator in facilitating the adult caregiver courses. These volunteers will assist in taking notes, implementing activities, assist in debriefs, and leading classes once familiar with the curriculum.

YOUTH EDUCATION FACILITATOR: Ensures that participating children remain safe and comfortable during class time; volunteers may implement and facilitate curriculum for different ages during class. The youth curriculum is trauma-informed and achieves healthy relationships through constructive play, interactive activities, and more.

SUBJECT MATTER EXPERT: A subject matter expert is someone who specializes in a specific topic. These individuals will be willing to present to caregivers or youth on the topic they specialize in. Topics include but are not limited to: Child Development, Special Education, Sex Education, Internet Safety, Housing, Mental Health, Health Care, Financial Guidance, and more.

RESOURCE VOLUNTEER: The resource volunteers assist with keeping the resource room and its contents neat and organized. They will assist with logging inventory and placing new donations in correct locations.
