CHILDREN'S CLASS VOLUNTEER

The ability to speak some Spanish is desired but not required. The Spanish Children's Education Volunteer ensures that participating children remain safe and comfortable during class time. Volunteers interact with children through activities, crafts, games, and the class curriculum. The youth curriculum is trauma-informed and achieves healthy relationships through constructive play, interactive activities, and reading time. If the volunteer is Spanish speaking, another role would be to assist in some translation between the Youth Development Coordinator (staff) and the children.
